Our children in Daisy Nursery are still really enjoying mark making. Following their interest we are continuing to add more resources and various messy play activities to encourage gross motor movements. We mixed powder paint and water to make our own paint, mixed corn flour with water in a tuff spot and explored making circles, lines and swirls in the sticky paste. We modelled language new and old such as "big circle" and "small line" as the children explored making marks.





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Our children are showing great interest in looking after our growing area in nursery. They are so helpful and love to water the newly growing plants. They are fascinated to see the little seedlings growing in the pots and will call the adults and friends over to show them. We often hear,
