Daisy Nursery Learning Focus Share Spring Term 2

We have been learning about the season Winter and how cold the weather can be in Winter. Children explored frost and ice in our garden and tried to get the toys out that were stuck in the ice! We learnt that we need our coats, hats, gloves and scarves on before we go out, as it is very cold. We introduced vocabulary such as "melting, frozen, temperature and cold".















Our children really enjoyed creating a winter collage. It was amazing to see them working collaboratively while painting "gluing and sticking by sharing the paint brushes, rollers and glue sticks. We introducing layering of materials on top of each-other. Some of the children commented on the marks they made in the paint with the glue "A circle".























In the last few weeks we have been learning about shapes and how we can use them in our play. Adults have been naming the shapes during play and modelling various ways to identify shapes in the environment or create new ones. Children are showing their understanding and imagination through placing and arranging different objects to make their own shapes and structures.





















Our children have been given time to enhance their fine motor skills when learning to thread large pieces of fruit onto a string and using the tweezers to pick and sort the pom poms into different colours. We are so proud of them for listening to the instructions and persevering to learn a new skill.
